Order of Ceremony

10:30	Invited guests and public arrive.
11:00	Minister arrives: Welcomed by dignitaries, general salute with bugle call. Includes RNZAF fly by.
11:02	Minister inspects the NZDF and Cadet Guard, escorted by dignitaries.
OC	Minister introduced to veterans (to include contemporary veterans) and address informally.
11:15	Cadets move to line pathway.
11:17	Minister moves to Memorial Pathway (followed by dignitaries, veterans and joined by invited guests).

The vision for this project was born a number of years ago when Mason Robinson was appointed the NZDF bugler to support the unveiling of a WWI Statue on the ANZAC Bridge in Sydney. Mason recalls an inspiring bronze statue about three metres tall, resting on arms reversed. When he returned to Nelson and played his next Last Post for the Nelson RSA he noticed two things vividly; firstly the stunning beauty of the local Marsden Valley Cemetery and secondly the distinct lack of War Memorial recognition for the veterans buried there. That was the moment the project was hatched.

The idea was supported by the Nelson City Council, with the statue being constructed in 2016. After the statue was completed Mason realised that the surrounds for the statue were not at all appropriate and he quickly implemented the second stage.

Using his contacts and with the Nelson RSA, it was not long before the NZ Army got involved. The Engineers from Burnham completed the amazing task in four weekends and three weeks.

The most overwhelming feeling Mason recalls was “the engagement from all areas of the Nelson community.”

“There certainly is a chord that is struck when it comes to WWI with remembering exactly what happened and the sacrifices our local soldiers gave.”

In Memory of...

John Herbert Cock

This War Memorial was unveiled on the centennial of the death of prominent Nelsonian John Herbert Cock, who was killed in action while serving in the Royal Flying Corp.

Cock, who was born in Nelson in 1893 and educated at Nelson College, enlisted in the Wellington Infantry Battalion on 13 August, 1914. After training in Egypt with the New Zealand Expeditionary Force he landed at Gallipoli in April 1915 and was seriously wounded the same month.

After being invalided to New Zealand he returned to duty in October 1915 and in May 1916 he was wounded in France. He transferred to the Royal Flying Corp in September 1916 and started flying training, only to be shot down and killed in April 1917.

Our Statue

The statue was created by Oamaru artist Don Paterson. He has created a very believable expression of a soldier who is exhausted, bewildered and generally buggered, after the days events on the battlefield. The Nelson RSA passes on their sincere thanks for this tremendous work that will make a huge difference in our beautiful 'Returned Services Hill'.







Moving the statue into place was an emotional time. Six of the NZ Army team needed to carry him like a coffin up the Memorial Pathway. He was very heavy and we all knew he was the heartbeat of the project. Once the statue was stood in place, within the safety of his WWI-style bunker, he overlooks the 662 WWI veterans buried in the cemetery.

MARSDEN VALLEY CEMETERY HISTORY

This is Nelson's main cemetery and is located up Marsden Valley on the inland side of The Ridgeway in Stoke. It was once known as Poor Man's Valley (Poorman's Valley), in part due to the tough conditions there in the 1840s and 1850s. Thomas Marsden, who arrived on the Prince of Wales in 1842, tried to build a house on the rise near what is now Block 7A. An easterly gale ripped it down, so starting in 1849 he rebuilt his home as a four room cottage on the site of what became known as Isel House. The cemetery was opened in 1956. It is unique in that all headstones are set flush with the ground which maintains the park-like surroundings. There is a touchscreen near the Sexton's office where it is possible to type in a surname and get an indication of where to locate the grave.

LAYOUT OF BLOCKS

The main part of the cemetery, known as the General Block, is made up of Blocks 1A to 21A, starting on the rise above the amenity block and running eastwards. 22A and 23A are not part of this pattern. Differentiating between the blocks is not always easy, so Row numbers have been added for each

section. All sections of the cemetery have maps on boards nearby and most graves are identified on the map by surname which can be helpful.

Block B is on the lawn area on the downhill side of the road running past the Returned Services Hill. Most of the graves on this lawn are unmarked and un-named. Block 23A is nearby with named graves and a nearby map board.

Block C is the Catholic Section, including 1C to 10C starting at the Sexton's end of the area. Row numbers have been added and run parallel to the road from R01 to R12 up the slope.

Block D is the RSA section. Graves in Block 1D and 2D are to the left of the path to the flagpoles, 3D and 4D to the right of the flagpoles. 5D to 8D are on the slope above the flagpoles. Row numbers have been added, starting at the bottom of the slope with LR01, and RR01, and running through to about LR20 and RR20. LP numbers and RP numbers are the roses either side of the path to the flagpoles. The cremation lawn is on the slope to the left of Blocks 1D and 2D. Again, the rows are numbered from the bottom of the slope nearest the road. The Section map boards can be very helpful in this area.



In addition there are nearly **500 roses around the cemetery** which can have up to 4 plaques around the base. The layout of the roses is outlined here and should be read in relation to the Cemetery Map on the following page.

Rose Area 1&2 – close to the office/toilet block opposite the Sextons Office

Rose Area 3&4 – inside and outside the drive up the side of the Children's Area

Rose Area 5 – on the main drive up to the circular roundabout in the General Area

Rose Area 6 – inside the first section of Area 5, moving up the hill

Rose Area 7 – across the lawn below Block 1A, on the right

Rose Area 8 – on the circular roundabout

Rose Area 9 – above the circular roundabout at bottom of the middle lawn

Rose Area 10 – surrounding the middle lawn containing Blocks 11A to 16A

Rose Area 11 – Parallel to the road beside Block 22A, running back down beside the trees as well

Rose Area 12 – referred to as the Big Rose Block – to the left of the drive to the Returned Services Hill, arranged in 12 rows

Rose Area 13 – at the bottom of Block 17A above the second turning area
Returned Services Hill Roses are labeled LP and RP in the database, standing for Left of Path to War Memorial and Right of Path to War Memorial.

More recently there have been cremation interment sites added along the kerbsides and along walls

on the top end of the cemetery but no WWI veterans are included there.

Finally there are Memorial Walk areas amongst the trees near the main entry gate MWA and MWB. Locating specific sites in this area is not very easy.

WWI VETERANS

World War One veterans are buried throughout the cemetery. 288 of them are on the Returned Services Hill section but an additional 374 are to be found in other areas. More than 200 in Block A but there are 32 in Block C, 61 around the Roses, and a handful in Block B and the Memorial Walks.

The database is arranged alphabetically with a brief description of the service provided by the veteran. The information comes from the Cenotaph Database at Auckland War Memorial Museum and through Archway at Archives NZ. It is possible that in some cases the named person may have been hard to confirm and there may be a very small number not identified. Outside of the Returned Services Hill area only about 60 plaques have reference to War Service included. Many of the names with Nelson links are also on the **Wall of Remembrance** at Founders Heritage Park.

MAINTAINING THE PLOT

Plaques in the lawn areas are mown over and can sometimes be partially buried by grass and weed. Please do not use herbicides. A sharp knife and a stiff brush will quickly make the area tidy. Flowers get dragged out by the Paradise ducks and pukekos and will eventually be mowed over. DO NOT leave glass or metal containers with flowers because these cause serious hazards for other visitors and for the grounds staff.
